## Frequently Asked Questions

### ***Are there accommodations available?***

Yes, at [Waterloo College Hall \(88 Seagram Dr.\)](#), book via the [Reservation Portal](#) \$65/night and includes parking on campus at Laurier. Check-in time is 2 p.m. and check-out is 11 a.m.

Check-in for all buildings is at the Hotel Laurier office  
located in the King Street Residence ([200 King Street North](#)).

The office is open daily from 8 am to 10 pm. Parking permits are provided at check-in, and they must be displayed at all times. Failure to clearly display the permit, and/or park in designated parking areas, may result in a ticket and/or tow by Laurier or the city. Laurier and the KW Wargaming Guild are not responsible for parking tickets received by guests.

### ***Can I bring my own food or drink onsite?***

Yes, you can bring your own food and drink (non-alcoholic). Bar on-site will be open for beverages and a bake sale for treats. There are nearby restaurants at University Plaza or you can order your own via Uber/Doordash etc. Note that there is no microwave available on site.

### ***Where should I put my stuff when I arrive?***

We would like everyone to bring their stuff onto the rink surface where games are being played. This will keep the common areas free and clear of bags, that way when you're done with a game there will be plenty of space in the viewing deck space to hangout.

### ***Do I have to pay / register for parking?***

No, parking is free and there is nothing you need to do to register. Also because we moved the event to June, the lots are less busy so you shouldn't have any issues finding a spot. Note this does not include the Laurier lots where the accommodations are (see above).

### ***Is the bake sale cash only?***

Yes, the bake sale is cash only.

***Is the bar cash only?***

No, you can pay with credit/debit at the bar.

***How do I claim my raffle tickets that came with my entry fee?***

Unfortunately we don't have an easy way for us to collect the info digitally for these redeemable tickets, so the easiest flow we have is basically for you to come and "buy them" as if they were cash tickets except we don't take any money from you. Scotty, Alex, and Thomas will be available throughout the day at the raffle prize table to take your info so you can claim your tickets.

***Can I buy raffle tickets even if I can't be there on Sunday to claim the prize?***

Yes, because the raffle is digital we will have your name/email and we will follow up with winners that weren't available to claim their prize to coordinate getting the item to you. Either via shipping it or finding a way to drop-off/pickup.

***How does the trading outpost work again?***

Buy spots and then bring your items (Saturday morning between 8:30am-10am) labeled clearly with your name and price (do this at home ahead of time). You'll check-in with our volunteers to ensure they have all your contact info to track and handle sales for you. On Sunday at 4pm you can pick up your unsold items and we'll send you an e-transfer for the amount sold. Each 8' x 2.5' table is divided into 8 individual slots (approx. 2' x 1.25' each). You can reserve more than one.

***How do I buy things at the trading outpost?***

The Trading outpost is e-transfer for only. Derek Satnik is running the Trading Outpost. When you want to purchase you'll send the money to [dsatnik@mi-group.ca](mailto:dsatnik@mi-group.ca) and it will be recorded on our tracking sheet. This is done so that there are zero-payment processing fees and so that we're not handling larger volumes of cash.

***Is there first aid on site?***

Daniel Widdis is our trained first-aider who will be onsite for the weekend. There is a first-aid kit and AED on-site. If you're in distress or find someone in distress do not hesitate to call 911 first, then find help from Daniel or our event staff.
